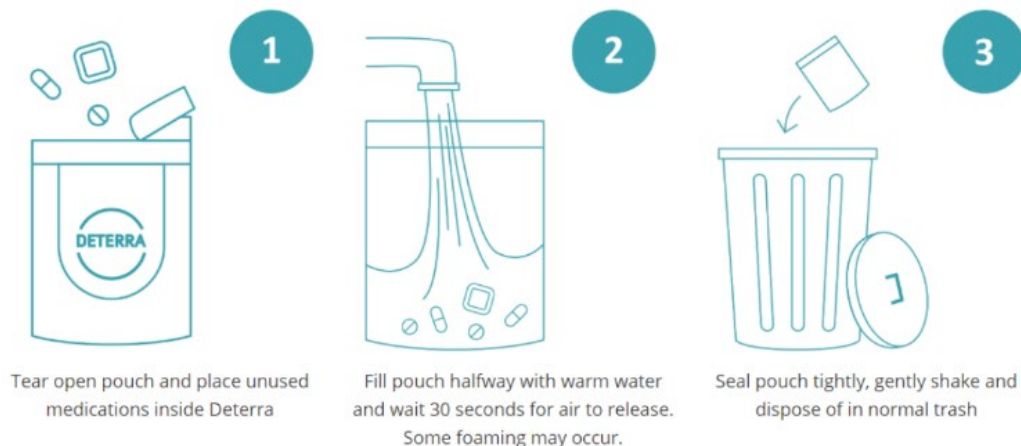
### Home disposal - Deterra Bags:

Geauga County Public Library is collaborating with Lake-Geauga Recovery Centers to make Deterra bags available at all library Branches as a free resource to Geauga County residents.

Deterra is an independently tested, safe, and environmentally sound solution to permanently deactivate, destroy, and dispose of unneeded pills, patches, liquids, creams, and films right at home. Deterra offers community members a chance to safely dispose of leftover, unused, or expired drugs. A user can bring the Deterra bag home and in a simple 3-step process, can deactivate and dispose of drugs, thereby preventing drug misuse while protecting the environment.

#### How To Use

In three easy steps, the Deterra® Drug Deactivation System neutralizes drugs permanently, safely and quickly.



*To deactivate and dispose of used transdermal patches, attach the sticky side of the patch to a paper towel and insert into the Deterra pouch. For unused patches, remove packaging and protective liner before attaching to paper towel.*
