Before dropping off unwanted medication, you should remove the label or black out your name and personal information so that it is unreadable. Medications should be left in their original container. Drop off sites are not equipped to receive liquids, needles or syringes

## Home disposal - Deterra Bags:

Geauga County Public Library is collaborating with Lake-Geauga Recovery Centers to make Deterra bags available at all library Branches as a free resource to Geauga County residents.

Deterra is an independently tested, safe, and environmentally sound solution to permanently deactivate, destroy, and dispose of unneeded pills, patches, liquids, creams, and films right at home. Deterra offers community members a chance to safely dispose of leftover, unused, or expired drugs. A user can bring the Deterra bag home and in a simple 3-step process, can deactivate and dispose of drugs, thereby preventing rug misuse while protecting the environment.



To deactivate and dispose of used transdermal patches, attach the sticky side of the patch to a paper towel and insert into the Deterra pouch. For unused patches, remove packaging and protective liner before attaching to paper towel.
