In previous years, documentation sometimes only reported "1 trailer load" or "300 tires" which can vary greatly in weight. Your Scrap Tire Transporter should be able to report with reasonable accuracy the weight of tires they removed for disposal for your event. This will help us greatly in producing our annual report to the Ohio EPA.
